## X 002. Matthew 6:9-15.      *The Lord's Prayer*

This story is found in the Gospel of St. Matthew, Chapter 6 verses nine to fifteen inclusive, so we write it like this: **Matthew 6:9-15.** *BibleHomework* uses this format throughout its website.

### The Scripture:

9 "This, then, is how you should pray:

    "“Our Father in heaven,  
    Hallowed be your name,  
    10 your kingdom come,  
    Your will be done,  
    on earth as it is in heaven.  
    11 Give us today our daily bread.  
    12 And forgive us our debts,  
as we also have forgiven our debtors.  
    13 And lead us not into temptation,  
    but deliver us from the evil one.’

14 For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. 15 But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins.

## The Explanation:

Jesus speaks to the people gathered around him on The Mount. He teaches them how to pray quietly to God in the silence of their rooms, and these are the words he teaches them to say.

1. What does 'hallowed' mean?
2. When Jesus says "Your kingdom come", what is Jesus signifying here?
3. When we say "OK, your rules" ... what words do we use to say this in The Lord's Prayer?
4. Why must we forgive our debtors?
5. Deliver us from who? Who is the 'evil one'?
6. If we forgive other people , what will God do?
